

# Local Rules in Effect at St. Enodoc

With effect from 1<sup>st</sup> August 2018

## Local Rule – Embedded Ball

Through the green, a ball which is embedded in its own pitch-mark may be lifted without penalty, cleaned and dropped as near as possible to where it lay but not nearer the hole. The ball when dropped must first strike a part of the course through the green.

## Local Rule – Water Hazard 5<sup>th</sup> Hole Church Course

The water hazard in the 5<sup>th</sup> hole of the Church Course has been designated an Environmentally Sensitive Area. Entry into and/or play from this area is prohibited for environmental reasons.

If it is known or virtually certain that a ball that is in an ESA defined as a water hazard, the player must, under penalty of one stroke, proceed under Rule 26-1.

NB 1: Balls may not be recovered

NB 2: The path is an obstruction within the hazard. There is no relief from an immovable obstruction within a hazard.

## Local Rule – Out of Bounds, 11<sup>th</sup> Hole Church Course

Players will notice there are no longer any white OOB markers on the 11<sup>th</sup> hole of the Church Course. As referenced now on the scorecard, a ball in or over the white line is deemed to be out of bounds.

## Local Rule – Red and Yellow Stakes

Golfers are reminded about the local rule concerning stakes marking lateral hazards and water hazards. Red and yellow stakes are considered immovable obstructions and relief may be taken under Rule 24.

## TEMPORARY LOCAL RULE – Ground Under Repair

Areas identified as Ground Under Repair are marked with blue lines.

## **PENALTY FOR BREACH OF RULE:**

Match play; loss of hole.

Stroke play; two strokes.
